Discover Levada



and is very loosely interpreted as 'carriageway'. A more correct translation would be mini-canal. The levadas were originally created in the 16th Century to bring water from the rainy northern aspect of the island to the sun soaked south where crops such as sugar, bananas and grapes grow. You will have a magnificent walk along the levada of Serra do Faial which is over one hundred years old. Starting in Vale do Paraiso and finishing in Rochão. Along the way you'll see cultivated terraces, spectacular gardens and beautiful views over the village of
