AM/PM Alentejo

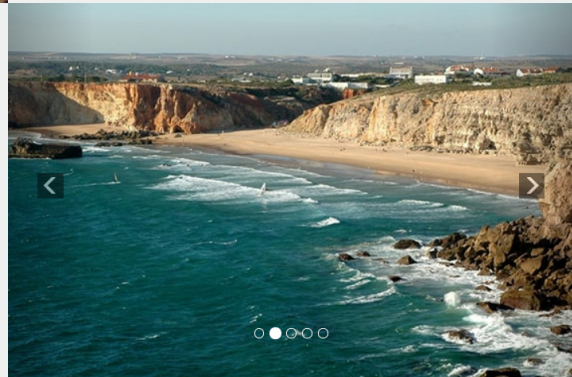
